

DINING HALL CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

After extensive study, planning, and preparation, the Council Executive Board has authorized a capital campaign to restore and enlarge our historic Dining Hall. Centered around the theme, "On My Honor ...Shaping Tomorrow's Leaders," this campaign will seek to raise \$2,000,000 in public support from January 2007 through June 2009.

Due to the Dining Hall's current capacity of only 350, we have been forced to seat an overflow of Scouts outside under a tent for the past several years. Inclement weather can make this a very unpleasant experience. The Addition will alleviate this issue by increasing seating to 500.

Another issue is the outdated kitchen where many of the appliances are over-used and wearing out. New equipment will increase efficiency and save energy. The Addition will also give us the ability to place equipment in a more practical and usable design.

Finally, the new Addition will create space for conferences and training which can be used year round, saving the Council rental fees at other locations.

Contributing to this campaign is a win-win situation. You, as a Donor, will see your funds being effectively utilized. The Council will be able to save money and use future donations for other areas of need. And, more importantly, the Scouts will have a great facility to enjoy, cherish and create fond memories that they will remember for the rest of their lives.

The following form describes our "Brick Sidewalk Program" where you may donate \$1,000 and have a recognition brick placed in the walkway leading to the new Conference Room on the lower floor of the Addition. The form also mentions other giving levels that you may contribute to, or you may give any amount that you feel appropriate.
