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## OWL - *Outdoor Webelos Leader Training*

OWL training is NOT just for Webelos leaders! It is for all Cub Scout Leaders who may at some point be leading a Webelos den or helping a Webelos leader. If you are a Bear leader, now is the perfect time to go!

You will experience the training as a Webelos Scout. The training does not cover advanced outdoor skills, but rather it covers the basic skills you will need when working with the Webelos.

Since a big part of Scouting is Outing, you will learn the necessary information and skills to be comfortable in the outdoors, and the training will allow you to be successful in providing a Webelos outdoor program.

It is best if you have already completed Cub Scout Leader Basic Training. There is very little overlap between OWL and CSLBT, and it is essential that all leaders understand the basic policies, methods, and procedures of Cub Scouting. There is still time to pick up CSLBT.

This is an overnight campout, we will be staying in Atwater Lodge, but you may sleep in your tent if you choose.

After completing the OWL program, you will be able to:

- ⇒ Explain how the outdoor program runs progressively through the different age levels of Scouting.
- ⇒ Describe health, safety, and sanitation procedures for outdoor activities.
- ⇒ List the Webelos advancement requirements related to the outdoor program.
- ⇒ Discuss the values of the outdoor program.
- ⇒ Teach the Webelos Scouts the Naturalist, Geologist, Forester, and Outdoorsman activity badges
- ⇒ Describe camp site selection and set-up
- ⇒ Successfully plan, conduct, and survive a Webelos overnight campout.
- ⇒ Describe and demonstrate the proper procedure for flag raising and lowering, and how to fold a U.S. flag correctly.
- ⇒ Describe and demonstrate easy basic camping and cooking skills to the Webelos Scouts.
- ⇒ Demonstrate the proper ingredients of successful campfire program.
- ⇒ And much, much MORE!!!
