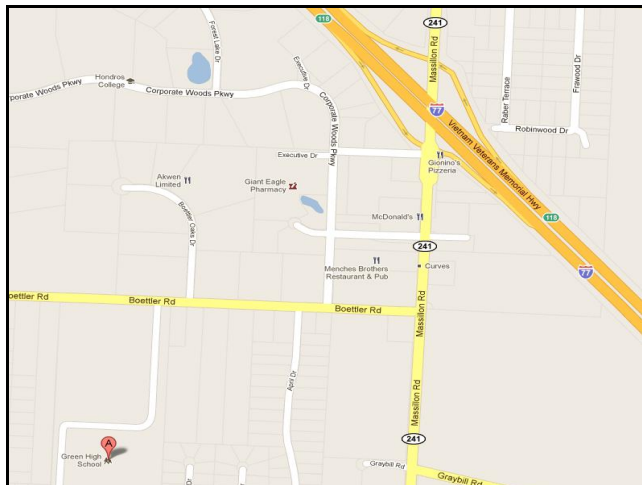


UNIVERSITY OF SCOUTING
